2010 Racial Justice Award

Purpose: To recognize and honor individuals, corporations, and organizations that work towards the elimination of racism and the promotion of racial justice.

Eligibility: The nominee should be an individual or entity who lives, works, or participates in community activities in the YWCA of the Harbor Area & South Bay's service area and has made a significant contribution to promoting racial justice in the community. The Racial Justice Community seeks nomination for individuals or groups that:

- Demonstrate a significant commitment to racial justice;
- Initiated or participated in a special effort or program in the area of racial justice in the community;
- Act as a role model for those whose lives they have touched.

Nominees: Some examples of those who could be nominated include:

- Community organizations that effectively address issues of racism
- A young person who took a stand for inclusiveness and racial harmony on behalf of someone else
- A business that effectively implements policies that result in employment equity
- Individuals who take active measures to address issues of racism
- Area actors, writers, or other artisans whose work promotes racial justice and interracial understandings.

Nomination Process: Complete the nomination form on the back of this sheet and attach a typed or legibly printed statement of 500 words or less that describes your reasons for nominating the person/organization/corporation for the Racial Justice Award. In your statement, please be sure to indicate the nominee's specific contributions to racial justice and how the nominee's efforts created lasting change or made a difference in the struggle to eliminate racism.

Those individuals or organizations selected will be honored at the YWCA's Annual Golden Circle Awards Banquet taking place in March 2010.
